NEW FROM USEF & USHJA !!

After much discussion about the costs of horse showing, the benefits to members and non-members, and “grass-roots” riders... the USEF and the USHJA have designed a new program to encourage participation

“Opportunity Classes”

Riders in these divisions are exempt from USEF & USHJA Membership Fees, and will also be exempt from paying the USEF Federation Fees (but must still comply with the Drugs & Medication rules and may still be subject to drug testing).

There are a few restrictions on the riders eligible to participate in this program, so see USEF Rule GR821 to make sure you are in compliance. In short: Riders may not have shown in any USEF rated division, horses may have. This is a great opportunity to welcome new riders to the world of recognized showing, and to introduce them to the USEF and USHJA!! If you have any questions about these divisions, please call Katie Benson at (908) 534-8833, or check in with our USEF Steward on the show day.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Please fax entries to (908) 832-6402, or phone to (908) 832-7402. Please use a completed entry blank and show ALL necessary proof of recording for every OWNER, RIDER, TRAINER and HORSE! An incomplete entry blank cannot be issued a back number.
2. Post entries will be accepted at no charge, but early entries are most appreciated.
3. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the currently USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
4. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
5. The Spring Valley Hounds, Briarwood Farm Horse Show, Briarwood Farm, Inc., the Committee, the Township of Harding, or the property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
6. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
7. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
8. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
10. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
11. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
12. Horses must enter entire division to be eligible for prizemoney.
13. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
14. All pets must be leashed.
15. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
16. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
17. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Evening Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions, and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/ discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1)headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity Classes; 9)citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ATTN EXHIBITORS: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorize vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competitions grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
