Schooling Hunter Division

Open to all. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners. Fence height is 2'6".

Open to adult amateur riders.

SIDE RING

Mini Stirrup Division

Open to riders who have not reached their 10th birthday as of December 1 of the current show year, have never shown over fences 2' or higher, or have cantered at any USEF-recognized show. Riders may not cross-enter into any other class or division where they are required to canter.

Beginner Equitation Division

Open to all-aged riders who have not shown over fences 2' or higher in height. Trotting on course is permitted. Riders may not cross-enter into any other class/division except beginner hunter or pleasure.

- 25. Beginner Equitation Walk/Trot/Canter
- 26. Beginner Equitation Walk/Trot/Canter (Crossrails)
- 27. Beginner Equitation Over Fences

Pleasure Horse or Pony Division

Open to all horses and ponies. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter in both directions. To be judged on soundness, performance, manners, and suitability. May be asked to hand gallop.

Lead Line Division

Riders must be 6 years of age or under.

Open to riders who have not reached their 12th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year and have not shown over fences 2' or higher at any USEF-recognized horse show.

Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year and have not won 6 blue ribbons. Riders may not cross-enter into any division where the fence height exceeds 2'9". Horses to jump 2'6", ponies 2'.
